





Median Max Speed Distribution by Location and Hour



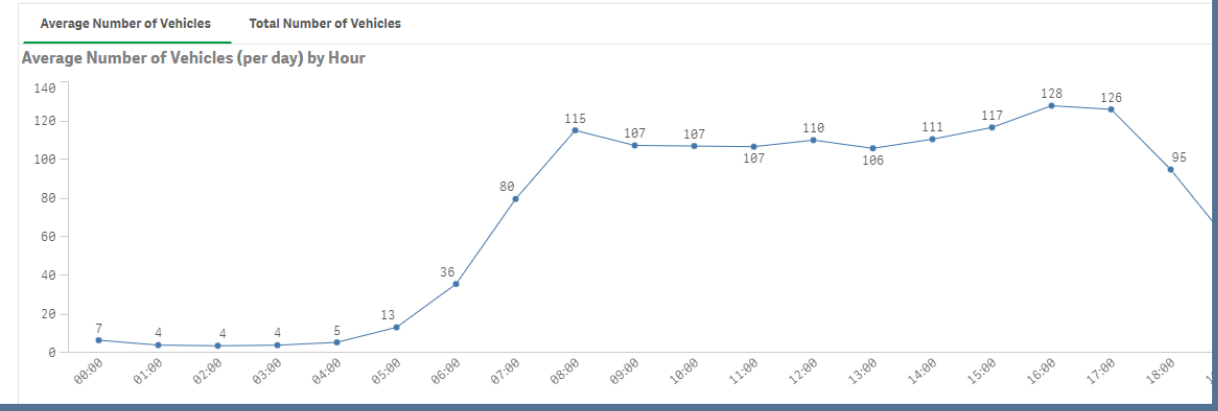

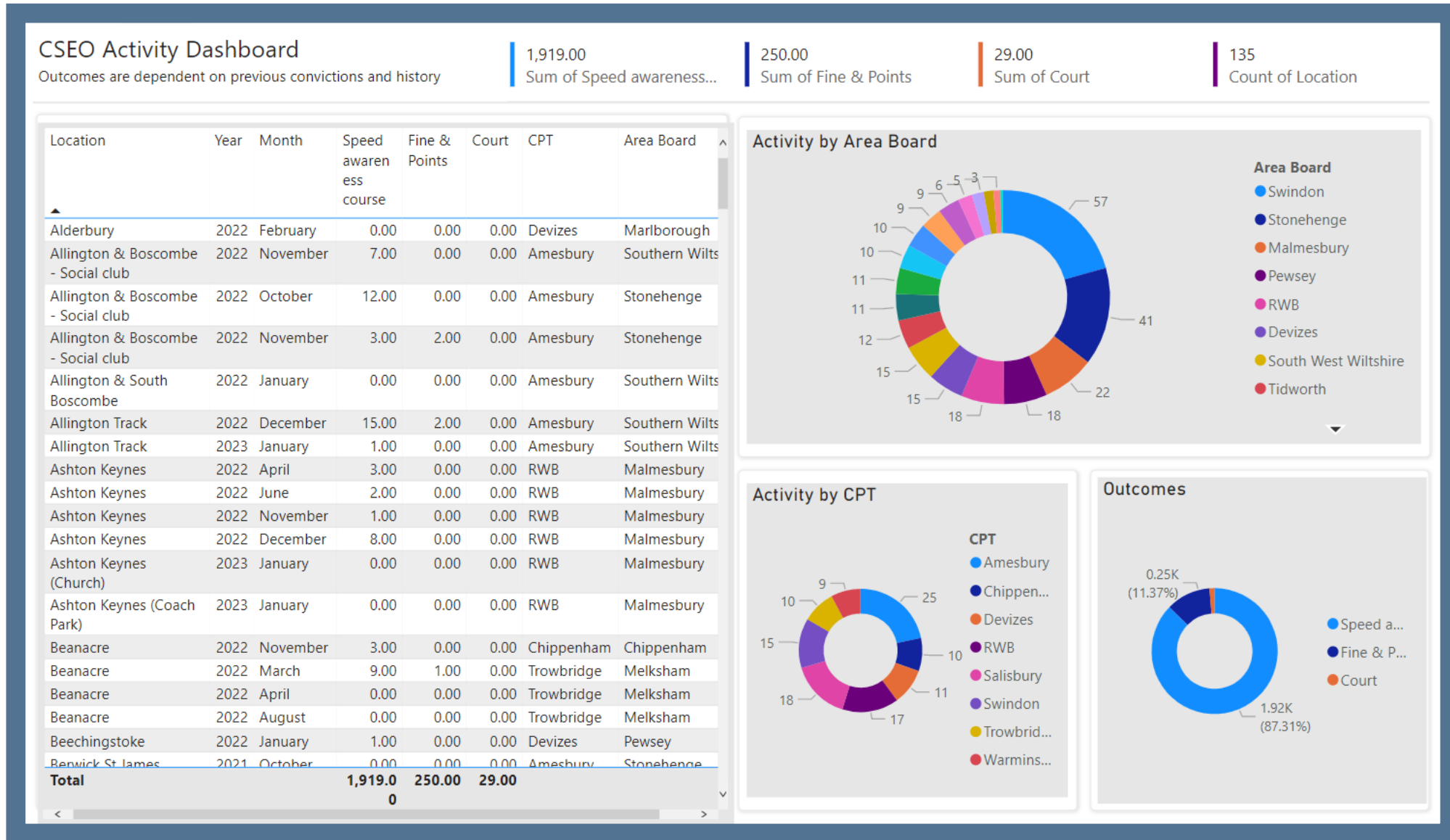

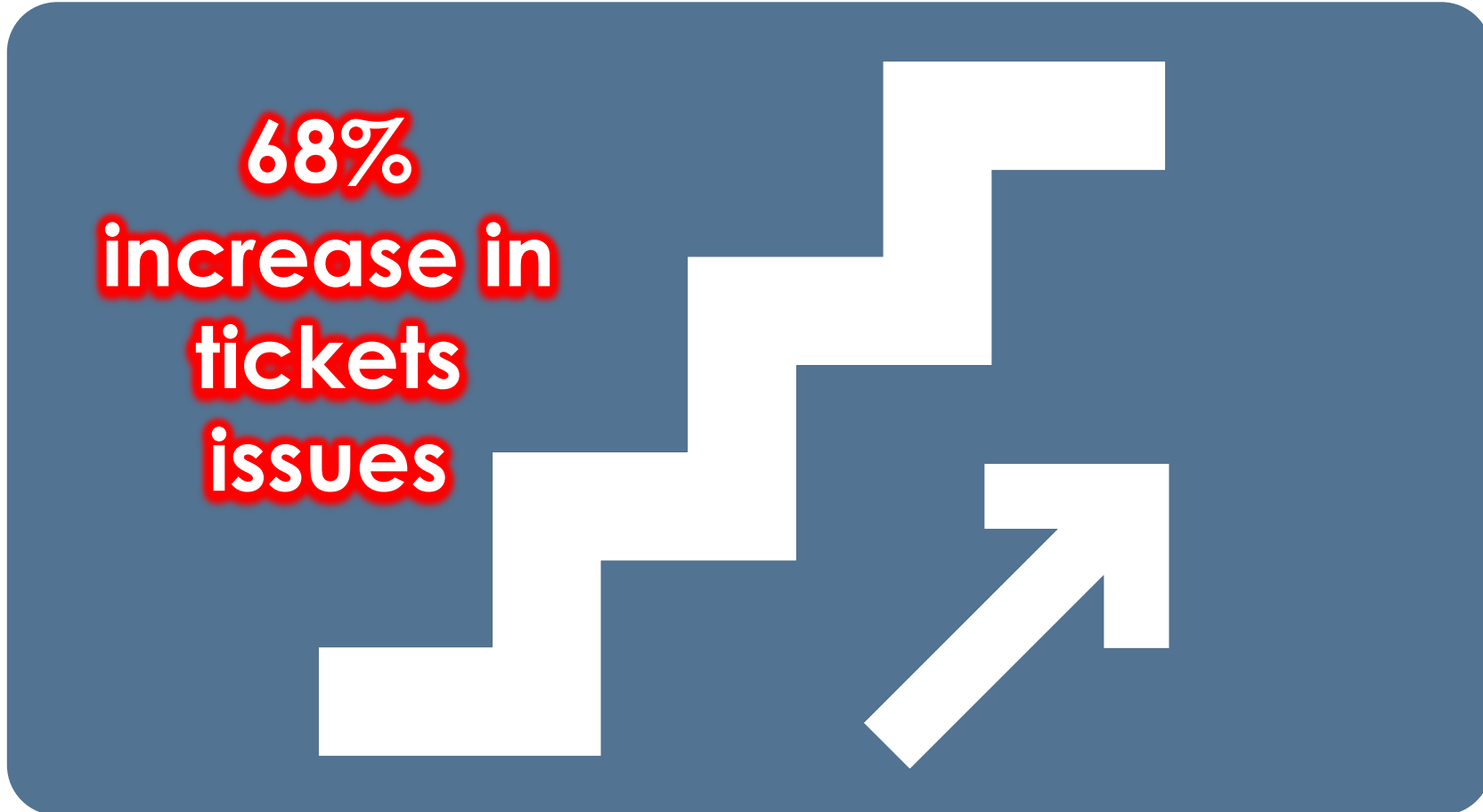

Outputs and Outcomes

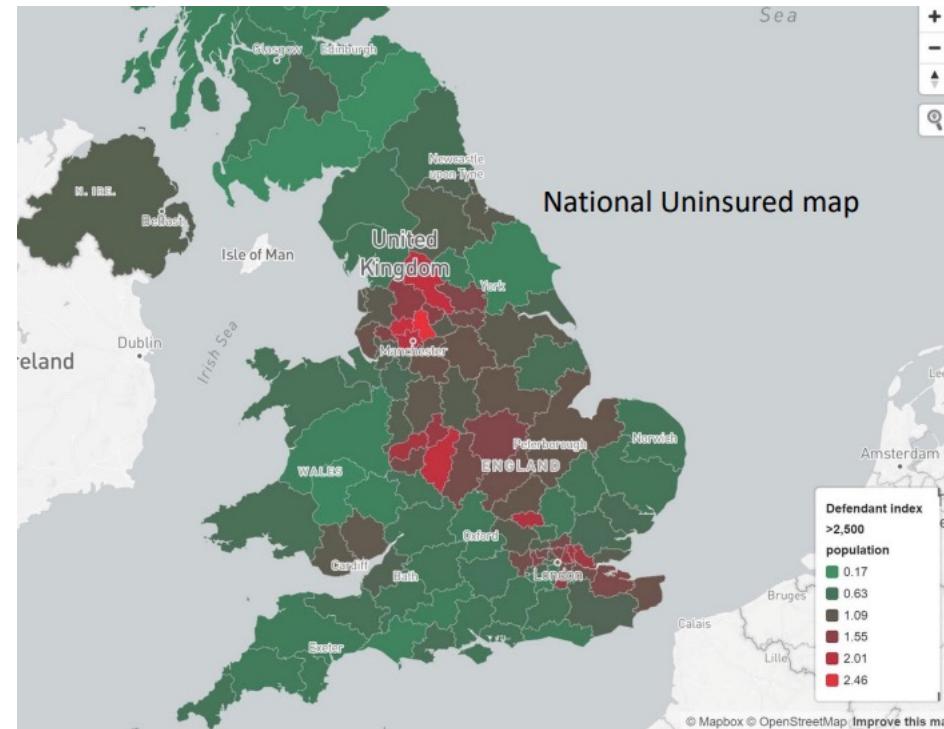


- Over 881,000 vehicles have been subject to Operation Tutelage
- Over 452,000 letters issued to Vehicle Keepers across the UK
- Over 346,000 vehicles have subsequently become insured as a result of [@OpTutelage](#) letters
- Resulting compliance rates vary across the UK, from 67% to 83%



• Op Drive Insured (MIB)

- Every year more than 130 people are killed on the roads of Great Britain by uninsured drivers
- Over 20,000 claims relating to uninsured driving handled by MIB
- £394 million national annual levy to fund those affected by uninsured incidents - £370m claims. Costs everyone £53!

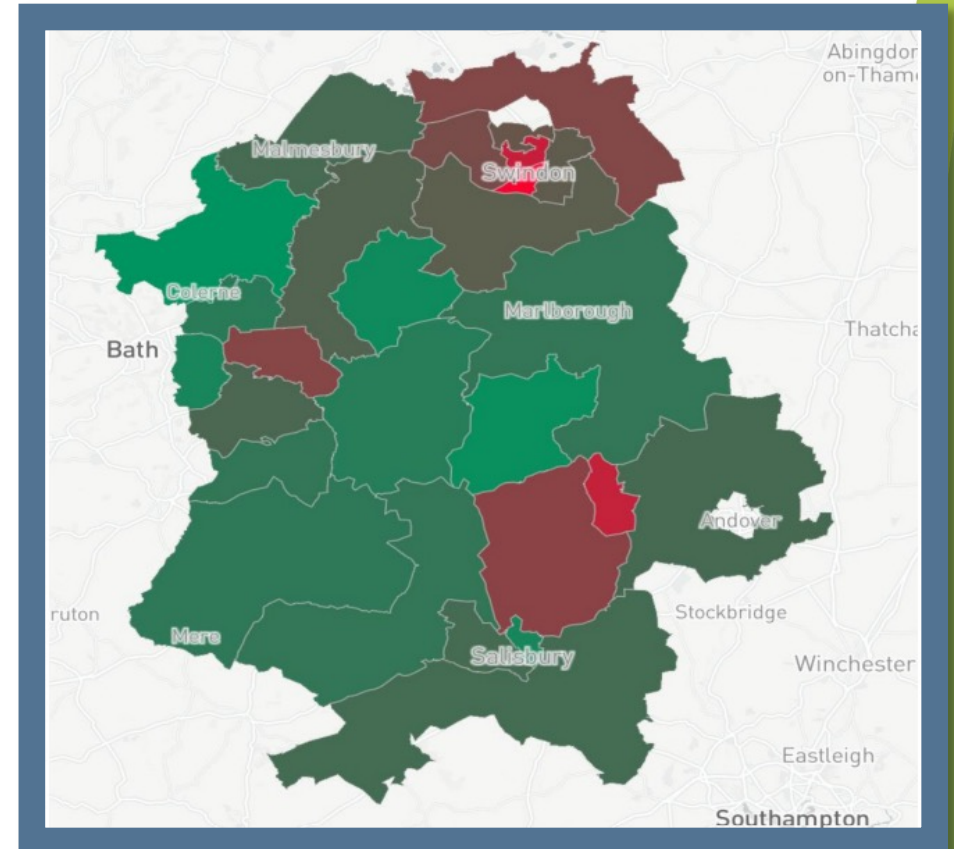
